## Day 1. Mon 18 Oct: Home - Adelaide - McLaren Vale - Goolwa - Murray Mouth

Lunch & Dinner

After our morning flight into Adelaide, we are met by our coach captain, board our luxury coach and begin our drive down through the delightful McLaren Vale where we stop by the family-owned, **Beach Road Wines**. Located in the heart of the McLaren Vale wine region with picturesque views overlooking the township and surrounding vineyards, we enjoy lunch and tastings. This afternoon we continue down to the **historic Murray River Port of Goolwa** where after visiting the **Goolwa State Heritage Centre** our **local guide** joins us for our **"Intro to the Port Tour"**. Our tour takes us in and around the historic port township, across to **Hindmarsh Island** and down to the **Murray Mouth Lookout**. We then travel onto Victor Harbor to check in to our accommodation for a rest before dinner in the Motel Restaurant.

## Day 2. Tue 19 Oct: Victor Highlight - Coorong Discover Lunch Cruise

Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

This morning at Victor Harbor we visit the **Former Customs House and Station Master's Residence** built 1866 consisting of six display rooms filled with magnificent heritage furniture, china and linen, memorabilia from 19th century and historic photographs of Victor Harbor. Our guide Richard then joins us onboard for a **'Victor History and Highlights Tour'** of Victor Harbor, Encounter Bay and Port Elliot. Following this tour we then enjoy some free time along side the Esplanade where those wishing can either take a stroll along the reserve, enjoy a cuppa or take the **Horse Drawn Tram** across to **Granite Island**. Back in Goolwa at the historic wharf we board our **Coorong Discovery Cruise** which takes us on a delightful journey into the mighty **Coorong National Park**. Our 3.5 hour cruise includes lunch and afternoon tea, two short guided walks, spectacular scenery, bird watching and the famous Murray River Mouth. After our cruise we return to our motel for a rest before dinner at the Hotel.

## Day 3. Wed 20 Oct: Kangaroo Island

Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

After an early breakfast and checkout we travel to **Cape Jervis** to board the **Sea Link Ferry** for our crossing to **Kangaroo Island**. On arrival at Penneshaw we are met by **our experienced Kangaroo Island guide** and begin our adventure of the Island. Our first top is at **Clifford's Honey Farm**, where we learn about the placid Ligurian Bees, their breeding and the production of over 10,000 kilograms of pure honey annually. Kangaroo Island is thought to be the only place in the world where a pure strain of the Ligurian bees exists. Enjoy a taste of different honey varieties and the opportunity to purchase some of **Jenny's famous honey ice cream**. (Own expense)

Next we visit the **Raptor Domain** and experience an in-flight **Birds of Prey display** and afterwards at own cost, the opportunity to put a glove on and have a bird fly to us! Stop by **Emu Ridge Eucalyptus Oil Distillery** for lunch and a guided tour. The distilling process here has operated the same way since the 1890's. We are able to purchase a bottle of oil from the only commercial distillery still in operation in South Australia. After our tour we make our way to the **Kangaroo Island Brewery** for our last stop of the day, before heading to our accommodation for check in and dinner.

### Day 4. Thu 21 Oct: Seal Bay - Kangaroo Island Wildlife Park

**Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner**

This morning we head off early and travel down to the famous **Seal Bay Conservation Park**, the only place in the world where we can stroll with our guide through a wild seal colony. Seal Bay is home to around 600 of the rare Australian Sea Lions. After Seal Bay it's up to Parndana to the **Kangaroo Island Wildlife Park**. Kangaroo Island is well known for its thriving koala population however over 150,000 hectares has been lost due to recent events which has effected the koala population dramatically. We need to pull together to save this Australian icon. The Kangaroo Island Wildlife Park has started a fundraiser to raise funds for care, pain relief, medication and the infrastructure needed to house and treat the large number of koala and animals coming into their care. The wildlife park is home to over 150 native species and over 600 animals. Enjoy a guided tour of the park followed by lunch before making our way to **Emu Bay Lavender Farm** to learn about lavender production, see it in its various stages throughout the season and even taste some goodies made with lavender. Walk around the garden and visit the charming gift shop which sells lavender essential oils, scented candles and other Kangaroo Island lavender products. We then make our way back through Kingscote and out to **Reeves Point**, South Australia's first official European settlement from 1836 it is on the Australian Heritage List although after six months it was decided that the island's resources were insufficient to support the community. The Old Mulberry Tree which was planted in 1836 still bears fruit and the history of the Pioneer Historical Cemetery will also be covered. We then return to our accommodation for some leisure time before dinner in the restaurant.

### Day 5. Fri 22 Oct: Hahndorf - McLaren Vale - Adelaide

**Breakfast & Dinner**



After breakfast we travel back down to **Penneshaw** visiting the **Gateway Information Centre** which is home to the original **Frenchman's Rock**. The centre is also a great place to purchase souvenirs and local produce before we board the **10.30am Kangaroo Island Sea Link Ferry** for our return journey to **Cape Jervis**. Once back on the mainland we travel up to the **Historic German Village of Hahndorf**, Australia's oldest surviving German Village. We have time to stroll along the main street with its numerous craft and souvenir shops and a variety of cafés to purchase lunch. This afternoon we visit **Cedars, home of Hans Heysen** and enjoy a tour through the untouched family home and studio of one of Australia's most celebrated artists. This area of the Adelaide Hills and the rugged beauty of the Flinders Ranges was where he gained most of his inspiration. After our tour we make our way to our hotel in Adelaide for check-in and dinner.

### Day 6. Sat 23 Oct: Adelaide - Home

**Breakfast & Lunch**

On our last day, we visit **St. Peters Cathedral** to experience a guided tour of the church. Completed in 1904 after the foundation stone was laid in 1869, the Towers and Spires were built and consecrated in 1902 and have the heaviest and finest bells in the Southern Hemisphere. A major feature is the fascinating stain glass windows within the Cathedral, each with their own story. After leaving the Cathedral we travel through the **"City of Churches" taking in the iconic buildings, parks and gardens that the city is renowned for**. We then visit the **Adelaide Oval** where we will go behind closed doors and discover hidden secrets and relive celebrated moments. Witness the unique integration of the Oval's iconic heritage blended seamlessly with world-class facilities, access restricted areas and experience the roar of the crowd as we take to the ground through the interactive players race. Step into living history as we explore inside the iconic scoreboard and see where some of the world's greatest musicians have entertained sold-out crowds. We then make our way to the **Lions Hotel** for a light lunch before making our way to the **Adelaide Airport** to check-in for our flight home after enjoying a wonderful short break away with Trade Travel.
